Both workshops are designed to develop participants' work in relation to the GCSE Drama and A Level syllabuses.

A) Workshop A - Stage the Impossible.

A chance for participants to gain an insight into the staging of Headlong's *Earthquakes in London*. Students will gain an understanding into how the Director, Rupert Goold, and the Associate Director, Caroline Steinbeis, approached staging Mike Bartlett's text. By exploring the differences between Miriam Buether's original set design for the National Theatre and the UK tour version, students will engage with the production's innovative use of space. A mixture of text work and improvisation will create a greater understanding of the play and its unique use of the stage. Participants will develop their skills as performers as well as directors, whilst arming themselves with a wealth of knowledge about the production.

B) Workshop B - Tackling the Future.

Based on the themes and content of Mike Bartlett's play and Headlong's production participants will be challenged to respond creatively by making their own mini version of *Earthquakes in London*. This workshop is focused on developing students' devising skills as well as expanding their knowledge of Headlong's innovative production. Using stimulus material from Mike Bartlett's text, Rupert Goold's and Caroline Steinbeis' staging and Brecht's notion of Epic Theatre, the session will focus on the development of students as practitioners in their own right.
